The poorest and most disadvantaged groups tend to depend on climate-sensitive livelihoods (e.g. agriculture), which makes them disproportionately vulnerable to climate change.<sup>7</sup> These groups also lack the resources needed to weather harsh climatic impacts (e.g. better houses, drought resistant crops).
