Just open the PDF file and a big blue marking should appear. OpenOffice supports PDF/A. For some reason "PDF/A-1" is called "SelectPdfVersion" internally in OpenOffice. Just add 1 to that value and your output should be PDF/A. Of course, 300ppi is classed as high resolution, but if you chose above 300ppi, then if your image was 300ppi, it would not show.
